8:30pm: A historical presentation by Antonio Manuel, under the title "La Cabalgada de Frigiliana, You Only Love What You Know". "The Frigiliana Cavalcade: You only love what you know"

9:00pm A play of "La Cabalgada de Frigiliana" "The Frigiliana Cavalcade", which tells the real historical episode that took place in Frigiliana at dawn on July 23, 1548, when the Moriscos of Frigiliana, with all their belongings on their backs, headed towards the beach of Burriana from Nerja ready to leave their town. They were preparing to embark on a journey that would allow them to earn their long-awaited freedom in North Africa, although they did not know that a sad and dramatic fate awaited them. "

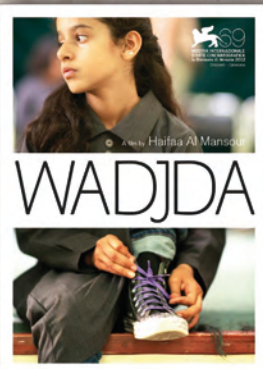
